In 2007, Frank was selected to present and perform at The National Conference on Student Leadership in Orlando, Florida where he won the coveted National Trendsetter Award. Since then, his services have been utilized by Non Profit Organizations, Social Service Agencies, Public schools & College Campuses.

Frank has been a proud member of the American College Personnel Association (ACPA), which allows him to stay up to date with current trends & issues in Higher Education. Frank was hired by ACPA to be the keynote closing performer for the ACPA National Culturefest. He has enjoyed a growing professional career as an Educator, who has had the opportunity to empower youth & college audiences to strive to their full potential. One of Frank's most memorable experience came in 2009 when he ran the Mayor's City of New Haven's Summer Youth Ambassador Program sponsored by the New Haven Youth Services Office. This opportunity gave him a chance

to train teenagers & college students in the areas of public speaking, professional presentation & research analysis. While not touring the country uplifting audiences, Frank has been a Teacher, Artist in residence & workshop facilitator for the New Haven Public School system. Currently he serves as one for the longest tenured Dream Directors for The Future Project, a non profit organization that works to empower teenagers in public high schools across the country. As an Artist, he has shared the stage with the likes of Big Sean, J.Cole, Dougie Fresh, KRS 1, Youthful Praise, Marion Meadows & Melanie Fiona to name a few.

He has had the opportunity to work with some of today's legendary musical pioneers. From Slick Rick to Hip-hop legend Jalil Hutchins of Whoodini, who offered him a performance spot on his 25th Anniversary Whoodini Tour. To add to his success, he has been highlighted in The Source Magazine for his opening performance at the biggest Old Skool reunion tour in Hip-hop History, Fresh Fest 2010. This led to him featured as a part of BET's 30th Anniversary programming. His love for the emotion of expression has taken him from Harlem street corners to sold out theaters. Whether it's been the Apollo Theater in Harlem or Whalley Avenue Correctional Facility, He continues to rise to his purpose, to inspire and change lives.
